# Updates

## New for 2018-2019 Report Card:

- The state continues to find ways to assess high schools other than just the ACT. Next year the ACT Aspire scores (9th and 10th grade) will be added to the HS report card.
- This change will give us a growth score at the high school level.
- We will also receive points for Youth Apprenticeship Program, student earned certificates (CNA and Auto Academy), and volunteer hours. We are waiting on guidance from the state on how to document those hours. Our students do a lot and this should benefit our score.

## Update:

- We will be getting a federal report card for the district and our each school first time in December, a certain group of schools can be labeled as a targeted school for improvement.
- We continue to do everything we can to keep our data up to date so our report cards can be as accurate as possible.
